

Notification Procedures - Red Alert
West Branch White River Lake
(Public Landing Fire # N3077 Lake Drive, Wautoma, WI 54982)

Description:

Any condition in which failure of the dam is likely to occur or failure of the dam has occurred, resulting in rapid depletion of the reservoir and/or uncontrolled downstream flooding creating a hazard to public health and welfare and/or structures. A "RED ALERT" condition indicates that dangerous high-speed, high volume flood waters are likely to occur in the river and flood-prone areas below the dam.

Attendant (Lee Simono - 920-787-7480) becomes aware of an emergency situation.

1. Attendant calls and notifies Wautoma Police Department (920-787-4044).
2. Attendant calls and notifies Waushara Sheriff's Office (920-787-3321).
Sheriff's Office will initiate appropriate county warning and notification procedures.
3. Attendant calls and notifies National Weather Service (262-965-2906).
4. Attendant calls and notifies White River Lake District Secretary/Treasurer (920-312-1148).
5. Attendant calls and notifies Deerfield and Wautoma Townships.

West Branch White River Lake Operation and Maintenance Plan

1. Grass cutting as necessary stopping within 15 feet of shoreline to act as buffer filter to lake.
2. Check and maintain deck at east side retention pond.
3. Inspect concrete walk and repair cracks as necessary.
4. Weekly check and cleaning of barriers that prevent debris from impeding free flow of water.
5. Periodic check to underground tubes for blockage (Never found blockage. Prevented topside.).
6. Repair flowage shed as necessary.
7. Monthly check of berm for decay or erosion.
